CORPORATIONS ARE NOT CITIZENS

"In *State Trading Corporation v. Commercial Tax Officer* [AIR 1963 SC 1811], a nine-judge Bench of this Court has settled the question that corporations are not considered as "citizens" under the Constitution.

A corporation cannot claim an infringement of rights under Article 19(1)(g), as this fundamental right is only available to citizens and not to juristic persons."
