### **REGISTRATION ORDER UNDER GST<sup>1</sup>, SET ASIDE<sup>2</sup>**

## (FAYIZ NANGAPARAMBIL vs. UNION OF INDIA<sup>3</sup>)

The Hon'ble Delhi High Court held that the Show Cause Notice was short of the necessary requirements as it did not contain any specific allegation. The court observed that the show cause notice is required to set out the relevant material in order to enable the noticee to implicitly respond to it.

#### HON'BLE COURT HELD AS UNDER:

- In the abovementioned case, The petitioner has challenged a Show Cause Notice<sup>4</sup> dated May 20, 2023, by which the petitioner was called upon to show cause as to why his GST registration was not canceled as the petitioner's GST registration is suspended with effect from May 20, 2023 and the only reason indicated in the Notice that the GST registration was obtained through Fraud, willful misstatement, or suppression of facts.
- The Hon'ble High Court set aside the impugned Show Cause Notice and clarified that the respondents are not precluded from issuing an appropriate Show Cause Notice, setting out the reason for proposing any adverse action against the petitioner. Thus, the suspension order of the petitioner's GST registration also stands quashed.
